Reserving High Holiday Seats

Please go to: <https://bit.ly/3jW1Br4> and fill out the Seating Request Form. This form should be filled out once per household, for all family members and guests.

Children of members: Children under age 7 are not assigned seats. In order to ensure enough seats for everyone, please request only as many seats as your family actually needs. Members are asked to pay the guest rate for children over age 25, whether single or married.

Guests: Members may reserve additional seats for relatives, and for guests who live far from Yedidya. Guest seats are NIS 100 per holiday per person (i.e., NIS 200 for both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur). Seats may not be reserved for “guests” who live nearby. People living nearby who want to reserve seats can either join the congregation as members or, if seats remain after September 15, 2022, they can obtain seats by making a contribution of NIS 700 per adult seat and NIS 300 per child seat.

Note! Seats will be reserved only if paid for in advance. We ask for your patience, cooperation, and understanding in this regard. Yedidya tries to honor seating requests but cannot guarantee that all requests will be accommodated. For questions or concerns, contact Dina Weiner (dina@reutschool.org).

Note: Members over 70 are asked to pay the full membership rate, but can automatically opt-in for the discounted rate as listed above.

In order to qualify for the early bird discount, your payment, accompanied by a completed membership form, must reach the Yedidya office (either electronically or in the Yedidya mailbox) by Sept. 1, 2022.

Children (up to age 25) of members who would like to become members themselves are eligible for discounted rates. Please contact the office for details.
